The Lake County Amateur Radio Association:

LCARA is an ARRL-affiliated Special Service club with some 100 members. While it sponsors FM Repeater systems on 147.210, 224.50 and 444.65 Mhz serving all of Lake County, the Association is much more than simply a “repeater club.” It’s full program of activities spans many areas of Amateur Radio interest: operating, radio construction, public service, field day, DX, ham tv, packet, and much more.

Member benefits include monthly meetings featuring interesting programs and guest speakers, the award-winning monthly newsletter-“The Patch”, social events, fox hunts, member nets and more.

Activities include Field Day, with LCARA ranked among the country’s top scorers; sponsorship of the annual Lake County Hamfest; Amateur Radio licensing classes; fun outings; several public service events yearly such as jogs, parades and road rallies; special event stations such as N200BC that celebrated the U.S. Constitution’s Bicentennial; DX info via the WT8C packet cluster; Homebrew Night; and an annual club dinner.

Objectives of the Association are to support technical improvement, education and public service through Amateur Radio Communications. Fellowship and mutual support are additional goals.

Meetings are held the first Wednesday of every month at 7:30 P.M. at the American Red Cross Headquarters, 1016 Bank Street, Painesville, Ohio, 44077. Occasionally, meetings will be held in alternate locations to accommodate special programs or club outings.

Lake County Amateur Radio Association Membership Dues Schedule

PARAGRAPH 2 – DUES AND CATAGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP

Item 1 Dues and Categories of Membership.

Dues and categories of membership shall be determined by the Board of Directors and approved by a simple vote of the quorum of Full Members present, as defined in the “Voting” section of the Constitution.

Item 1 – Regular and Senior Members

Dues for regular and Senior Members are \$20.00 per year, payable one year in advance based on the calendar year. Regular and Senior members have full voting privileges and are mailed the association newsletter.

Item 2 – Family Members

Dues for Family Members are \$10.00 per year, payable one year in advance based on the calendar year. One member of each family must be a Regular Member. Family Members have full voting privileges but will not receive a copy of the association newsletter.

Item 3 – Student Members

Dues for Student Members are \$10.00 per year, payable one year in advance based on the calendar year. Student Memberships are for students in grades one through twelve. They have full voting privileges and are mailed the association newsletter.

Item 4 – Associate Members

Associate Membership is for individuals who live outside of the area, but want to receive the association newsletter. Dues for Associate Members are \$16.00 per year, payable one year in advance based on the calendar year. They do not have voting privileges but will receive the association newsletter.

Item 5 – Initiation Fee

An initiation fee is not required at this time.

Item 6 – Dues Due Date

Membership dues are automatically levied and are due on January 1 of each calendar year, except for new members, whose dues are due on the day the applicant files an application for membership. Dues for the new members are prorated for Membership as set by the Board of Directors and approved by a simple vote of the quorum of Full Members present, as defined in the “Voting” section of the Constitution.
